- 1. Adoption of Agenda**                      Ralph Stahlhut moved that the Board of Education adopt the agenda of the regular and closed sessions, as amended. Randy McArthur seconded the motion. The motion carried: 6-0.

Pat Bryant asked that a moment of silence be observed in memory of the Huckaba family, Angela Huckaba, mother, Jacob, 4<sup>th</sup> grade, and Joshua, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students at Remington Traditional School, who lost their lives in a tragic accident a little over a week ago. Also, Mrs. Huckaba's younger brother and sister, Brent & Amy Willingham were killed in the accident as well. Mrs. Bryant stated Mrs. Huckaba was a Pattonville graduate, a substitute in the district, and a terrific parent volunteer.

**16. Superintendent's Update**

Dr. Kinney stated that New Teacher Orientation was held earlier today and it was exciting to see the enthusiasm of new staff as they gathered together. Cindy Candler said she enjoyed her time in Florida with her family and is excited for the new school year to begin. She also attended the New Teacher Orientation and the BOE/Adm. Kickoff. Mrs. Candler said in her visits to the schools she was impressed by how great the floors look at Bridgeway and the high school.

Randy McArthur reported he attended New Teacher Orientation. He said he will be unable to attend All Staff Orientation because of vacation.

Ron Kuschel stated he attended just about everything his colleagues have already stated. Mr. Kuschel said it was interesting at his house these days because his daughter, Erin, is beginning her first teaching job and the amount of time she is spending already at the school preparing her room for the first day with students is unbelievable.

Pat Bryant said she attended the New Teacher Orientation, BOE/Adm. Kickoff, and the *Characterplus* luncheon. Mrs. Bryant asked board members to let her know if they are unable to attend a committee meeting and she will either attend in their absence or try to find another board member to fill in.
