Pattonville schools make state's "highest performing" and "most improved" lists

Four Pattonville schools recently were named to the state's "highest performing" and "most improved" Top 10 lists based on scores on the Missouri Assessment Program (MAP) tests. The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education released the lists. The following Pattonville schools made the lists:

Highest Performing Top 10 Schools in Missouri

- **Rose Acres Elementary** (elementary communication arts for schools with between 250 and 500 students)
- **Remington Traditional School** (middle school math for schools with between 250 and 500 students)

This list includes the Top 10 schools in different size categories based on the percent of students who scored at the proficient and advanced levels on the MAP tests based on a five-year comparison (2001-2005).

Most Improved Top 10 Schools in Missouri

- **Remington Traditional School** (middle school math for schools with between 250 and 500 students)
- **Holman Middle School** (middle school math for schools with between 250 and 500 students)
- **Pattonville High School** (high school communication arts for schools with more than 500 students)

This list includes the Top 10 schools in different size categories based on the percent of students moving into the proficient and advanced levels based on the percentage increase from 2001 to 2005.
