

## **Pattonville make state's Top 10 lists for highest performing schools seven times**

Two Pattonville schools recently were named to seven of the state's "highest performing" Top 10 lists based on scores on the Missouri Assessment Program (MAP) tests. The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education released the lists. The following Pattonville schools made the lists:

- 1. Rose Acres Elementary** (third-grade mathematics for schools with between 250 and 500 students)
- 2. Remington Traditional School** (fifth-grade communication arts for schools with between 250 and 500 students)
- 3. Remington Traditional School** (sixth-grade communication arts for schools with between 250 and 500 students)
- 4. Remington Traditional School** (sixth-grade mathematics for schools with between 250 and 500 students)
- 5. Remington Traditional School** (seventh-grade communication arts for schools with between 250 and 500 students)
- 6. Remington Traditional School** (seventh-grade mathematics for schools with between 250 and 500 students)
- 7. Remington Traditional School** (eighth-grade communication arts for schools with between 250 and 500 students)

This list includes the Top 10 schools in different size categories based on the percent of students who scored at the proficient and advanced levels on the spring 2007 MAP tests.
