

## **Pattonville Board names new administrators**

The Pattonville Board of Education on May 13 approved two selections for administrative positions in the Pattonville School District. All of the new administrators will begin their roles on July 1, 2008.

Lisa Luna Schwarz was selected as principal of Remington Traditional School, a K-8 school of choice in the Pattonville School District. Schwarz is currently an assistant principal at Southwest Middle School in the Parkway School District. She also previously served as the K-12 communication arts coordinator for Parkway and completed administrative internships at middle schools in the Parkway and Kirkwood school districts. She worked as an elementary and middle school teacher in the Francis Howell School District prior to her administrative experience. Schwarz holds a bachelor's and a master's degree in education from the University of Missouri-St. Louis and is working toward completing her doctorate in educational leadership from Maryville University in December 2008. She will replace Shelly Mills, who was selected as the new assistant superintendent in the Ritenour School District.

The board also hired Robert "Bo" Ricker as assistant principal at Drummond Elementary School. Ricker is currently an administrative intern at John Weldon Elementary School in the Francis Howell School District and previously served as an elementary teacher. He holds a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Southeast Missouri State University and a master's degree in educational administration from Lindenwood University. He will replace Chip Ianiri, who was serving as an administrative intern and has chosen to return to the classroom.
